

Consecration of Auxiliary Bishop of Hong Kong

THE consecration of Auxiliary Bishop Francis Hsu will be held on the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary, 7th October at 5 p.m. at the Cathedral.

The consecrator will be Bishop L. Bianchi. The co-consecrators will be Archbishop S. Lo-kuang of Taipei, and Bishop P. Tou of Hsin Chu. The Most Rev. Mgr. J. Caprio, until recently Apostolic Pro-Nuncio to China and now Apostolic Pro-Nuncio to India, will preside over the ceremony.

A committee of priests and laymen, headed by Mr. Martin Quincey Wong, President of the Chinese Catholic Club, has been formed to organise the ceremony and reception.

The committee has found that the number of those wishing to attend the Consecration is far beyond the capacity of the Cathedral. It has therefore been judged necessary to limit entrance to ticket-holders. The tickets are being distributed through the parishes.

No parking will be allowed in the Cathedral Grounds.
