Most Reverend and Dear Confrère,

You have been given me by the Holy Father as my particular assistant and Auxiliary, to share in my pastoral vigilance and solicitude. Consequently - and also according to the Conciliar (Vat. II) Decree "Christus Dominus", De pastorali Episcoporum munere, no. 26, and according to the Motu proprio "Ecclesiae Sanctae", no. 13, §2 - I do hereby appoint you as my only Vicar General in the administration of my whole Diocese, "ad universalitatem negotiorum tam spiritualium quam temporalium", in conformity with can. 368.

It is understood that whenever I am absent from the Diocese, or were I to happen to be "impeditus", your powers would extend also to the temporal and spiritual matters which Canon Law habitually restricts to a special (written) mandate issued by the Bishop.

You will act as my Vicar General as long as you remain with me as my Auxiliary.

With this formal appointment I grant you all power, faculties, privileges, honours and precedence, which are given to a Vicar General by Canon Law, by Diocesan Statutes and by approved custom (with exception, however, of the judicial authority to judge in the Diocesan Tribunal).

And I declare this appointment to be effective immediately.
