

The Mission at Junk Bay Goes Ahead

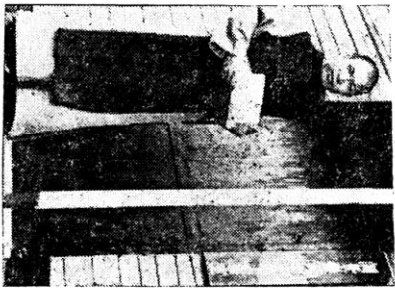

Clothes and Food Distributed



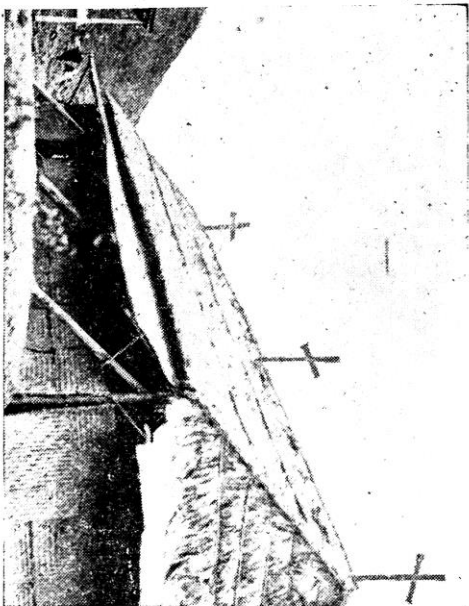
