

## CHINESE CATHOLIC YOUNG MEN'S ASSOCIATION



The eve of the Feast of Christ the King was a red letter day for Rosary Church. Before the Blessed Sacrament solemnly exposed, some 40 Chinese boys were officially received into the Chinese Catholic Young Men's Association by H.E. Bishop Yuen, from the North of China. Before the service the new flag of the association was blessed and left by the side of the altar, while badges were distributed to each new member as he knelt at the altar rail. Appropriate music was rendered by a group of boys and girls, including the "Ecce Sacerdos magnus" as the Bishop, preceded by the 40 members of the association and altar boys, stepped into the church, while from the belfry the bells chimed joyfully for the occasion.

The service in church was immediately followed by an "At Home" in the Parish Hall, interspersed with speeches, songs, games. Later in the evening the film "Song of the South" was shown in the Hall before a crowd of no less than 500 persons, thus bringing the day to a very successful conclusion.
