

NEW SCHOOL BUILDING IN TAI KOU LAO

“Little Flower” School Addition



THE parish of Our Lady of Lourdes in Tai Kou Lao Village celebrated last week the formal opening of its new school building. The school is an extension of the Little Flower Primary School which was opened two years ago by the Sisters of the Foreign Missions of Paris. Father R. Chevalier, M.E.P., the parish priest of Our Lady of Lourdes', blessed the new building. With the new extension, the Little Flower School has now 610 pupils in two sessions. Seventeen lay teachers and four sisters teach in the primary classes I to VI.

A new residence near the school has also been placed at the disposal of the sisters. The Institute of the Sisters of the Foreign Missions of Paris was founded in 1931. The Sisters came to Hong Kong in 1953 and there are five Sisters here. They have opened a novitiate in Tai Kou Lao. Aspirants may call to see the Superior at the Little Flower School.
