

# Installation of Bishop Peter Lei as Bishop of Hong Kong

Saturday 20th April

**T**HE Ceremonial Installation of Bishop Peter Lei Wang Kei as Catholic Bishop of Hong Kong will take place on Saturday, 20th April, 1974, at 3.30 p.m. in the Catholic Cathedral, Caine Road, Hong Kong.

It has been decided that there will not be any reserved seats in the Cathedral on this occasion, except for four representatives from each parish and from some diocesan organizations, schools, and from the various religious communities and for those invited from the Christian Churches and other religious bodies, e.g. the Buddhists, Taoists etc.

This means that the rest of the space in the Cathedral will be available for all who wish to attend.

The religious ceremony of installation will take place during Mass and will include the reading of the Papal letter of appointment, and a pledge of loyal cooperation from the priests, the religious and the lay apostolate and youth organizations of the diocese.

After the religious ceremony there will be a Reception in the Community Hall of Caritas House from 5-7 p.m.

It is regretted that parking space will not be available for the religious ceremony at 3.30 p.m. in the Cathedral, since it is expected that so many people will want to attend that they will be standing outside and around the Cathedral watching the proceedings.
